RE: Authority Meeting Engineers' Report

The following are summaries of CET's activities since the February 2, 2010 WTMA meeting:

WATER SYSTEM

Tapping Fee Update (1798.7002)

- ◆ CET received additional information from Glace, but a number of our questions remain unanswered. We are planning to meet with Sean next week to show him what we have been able to do to date, review the information we still need from WTMA, and agree on how to proceed.

SEWER SYSTEM

Risk Management Plan (1798.0100)

- ◆ The Risk Management Plan was submitted to EPA before the February 22, 2010 deadline and EPA acknowledged receipt electronically.

Old Forge Road/Calimer Drive Sewer Extension – Phase 2 (1798.0600)

- ◆ No activity by CET this month.

Sewer System Capacity Analysis Act 537 Special Study(1798.0800)

- ◆ CET addressed the Washington Township Planning Commission's in a letter dated February 24, 2010 and made minor updates to the study and resolution to be adopted by the Board of Supervisors. Once the adopted resolution is received from the Township, the study will be submitted to DEP.

NPDES Permit Renewal (1798.4004)

- ◆ The permit renewal application package was submitted to DEP and DEP issued a letter stating the application is administratively complete.
- ◆ WTMA received a 92.8a letter dated February 5, 2010 from DEP (as did all Phase III POTW's in the Chesapeake Bay drainage area). Sean is drafting a response letter, which must be submitted to DEP by early August 2010. The letter must include a report and schedule as to how WTMA

proposes to comply with the nutrient cap load requirements set forth in the letter. The information needed to respond to DEP's letter is included in the Act 537 Special Study that DEP approved last year.

- ◆ We anticipate that DEP will issue a draft NPDES Permit to WTMA in the coming months. We recommend that CET be authorized to review the draft permit and provide comments to DEP on the Authority's behalf, since there is a 30-day public comment period after the draft permit is issued.

Tapping Fee Update (1798.7001)

- ◆ CET received additional information from Glace, but a number of our questions remain unanswered. We are planning to meet with Sean next week to show him what we have been able to do to date, review the information we still need from WTMA, and agree on how to proceed.

Miscellaneous

- ◆ CET provided Consulting Engineers Certificates as requested by Brandee.
