

## **RESOLUTION 08-7**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR UTILITY ADJUSTMENTS ON HIGHWAY SR2008 FOR THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, FRANKLIN COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

In accordance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Design Manual- Part 5, Chapter 3.2, the Washington Township Municipal Authority does hereby authorize the submission of the attached request for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to provide a fixed 50 per centum (50%) reimbursement to Washington Township Municipal Authority for all costs incurred in raising the elevation of our manholes and our water valves located in public right of way and affected by the work to be done on SR2008 necessitated by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Highway Improvement in Franklin County.

Also the Manager of said Municipal Authority be authorized and directed to sign a Utility Reimbursement Agreement on its behalf and that the Business Manager be authorized and directed to attest the Manager's signature on the Utility Reimbursement Agreement for this highway project.

Cost Sharing Request

This correspondence is submitted in accordance with Chapter 3.2 of Design Manual Part 5, Utility Relocation, for referral to the Secretary of Transportation.

The proposed Highway Improvement Project of State Route 2008, between station 0+00 and Station 93+20, located in Washington Township in Franklin County requires the adjustment of manholes and water valves owned by the Washington Township Municipal Authority which are presently located in public right-of-way.

It is understood that the cost of adjusting our facilities in public right-of-way are normally at our cost and expense, but that under the provisions of Section 412.1 of the Act of June 1, 1945, P.L. 1242, as amended (36 P.S. 670-412.1), the Secretary of Transportation may determine that the Department will share in such cost.

Accordingly, it is hereby requested that the Department of Transportation share in the costs of adjustment of our sanitary sewer manholes and water valves, the total cost of which is estimated to be \$24,000.00.

The Washington Township Municipal Authority hereby offers to pay fifty per centum (50%) of the actual cost to adjust our water and sewer facilities presently located in public right-of-way, which is estimated to be \$12,000.00, provided the Department of Transportation will share in the balance of the actual cost thereof, less any betterment.

The Washington Township Municipal Authority hereby certifies that the forgoing offer is based on the Washington Township Municipal Authority's ability to pay with available uncommitted funds.

If the Secretary of Transportation accepts our offer and determines that the Department will share in the said costs as above stated, the Washington Township Municipal Authority hereby agrees to enter into and execute an Agreement prepared by the Department of Transportation with such terms and conditions as the Secretary may deem necessary and advisable.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is an executed resolution authorizing the Washington Township Municipal Authority Manager to make the within offer.
