SR 0997-036 AND SR 2007-013 INTO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT

In accordance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Design Manual - Part 5, Chapter 8.1.C, the Washington Township Municipal Authority hereby does authorize the submission of the attached request for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to provide a 75.00 per centum reimbursement to Washington Township Municipal Authority for all costs, less any betterments, incurred in relocating our sewer facility affected by SR 0016-048, SR 0997-036 and SR 2007-013 necessitated by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Highway Improvement in Franklin County.



Attention Utility Relocation

Dear Sir:

This correspondence is submitted in accordance with Chapter 8.1.C of Design Manual Part 5, Utility Relocation, for referral to the Secretary of Transportation.

The proposed Highway Improvement Project(s) of State Route 0016, Section 048, between Station 222+66 and Station 300+42, , State Route 997, Section 036, between Station 73+28 and Station 131+65, and State Route 2007, Section 013, between Station 000+00 and Station 75+56, all located in Washington Township and Waynesboro Borough in Franklin County requires the relocation and/or adjustment of certain sewer facilities owned by Washington Township Municipal Authority.

It is understood that the cost of relocating and/or adjusting our facilities are normally at our cost and expense, but that under the provisions of Section 412.1 of the Act of June 1, 1945, P.L. 1242, as amended, 36 P.S. §670-412.1, the Secretary of Transportation may determine that the Department will share in such cost.

Accordingly, it is hereby requested that the Department of Transportation share in the costs of the relocation and/or adjustment of our sewer facilities.

The Washington Township Municipal Authority hereby offers to pay 25.00 per centum of the actual cost to relocate and/or adjust our sewer facilities, provided the Department of Transportation will share in the balance of the actual cost thereof, less any betterment.

Furthermore, Washington Township Municipal Authority hereby agrees to execute an Agreement prepared by the Department of Transportation with such terms and conditions as the Secretary may deem necessary and advisable.

If the Secretary of Transportation accepts our offer and determines that the Department will share in 75.00 per centum, the Washington Township Municipal Authority hereby agrees to provide the information by the accelerated dates listed below:

- The justification for utility impacts no later than the agreed upon date of January 31, 2017.

- The utility relocation plans, specifications, and estimate/agreement package no later than the agreed upon date of January 31, 2017.
- The signed agreement to the Department no later than the agreed upon date of April 6, 2017.

Washington Township Municipal Authority recognizes and accepts that failure to meet the above stated milestones will result in the Department reducing its share to 25.00 per centum or 25% of the actual cost to relocate and/or adjust our sewer facilities

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is an executed resolution authorizing Sean McFarland, Manager, to make the within offer.
